GARBAGE COLLECTION RULES

BRUSH COLLECTION RULES

All brush (up to 6 inches in diameter and 6 feet in length) leaves, garden waste and weeds shall be placed separately on the terrace edge from **March 27th - until 6:00 am May 25th and from October 2nd - until 6:00 am November 21st**. Crews will start at 6:00 am on the end date and go through each ward once. Anything placed curbside after the crew passes will not be picked up. **PLEASE PLACE YOUR DEBRIS CURBSIDE BEFORE 6:00 AM ON THE END DATE!** DPW does not pick-up grass clippings.

In order to facilitate pick-up by the crews, the following rules apply: Pile brush separately on the terrace in neat stacks at the street edge away from trees, parked cars, fire hydrants, utility poles, mailboxes and other obstructions. Any piles contaminated with foreign objects, animal waste, grass, root balls, sod, rocks or dirt will not be picked up. If you hire a contractor to clear your property, *the contractor shall be responsible for the removal of all/any material generated. This includes trees and leaves.*

City trees are not to be trimmed by a property owner. The city will trim as required. Call 248-6644 for assistance.

There is NO curbside pick-up during the summer. However, free brush drop-off (up to 6 inches in diameter and 6 feet in length) of leaves, garden waste, and grass clippings is available to City of Lake Geneva residents *only* at the Street Department located at 1065 Carey Street - 24/7. Bags must be emptied and taken away or thrown in garbage cans provided. **NO CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS.**

NOTE: brush drop-off site is closed during Venetian Fest Week!

SIDEWALK / DRIVEWAY - SNOW REMOVAL

Per Municipal Code, sidewalk snow removal is the responsibility of the property owner, and shall be done within 24 hours of a snowfall (12 hours downtown). Failure to comply shall result in the City, or their hire, to complete sidewalk snow removal for the public safety and welfare. The property owner shall be billed twice the cost of labor & materials for this service (a minimum of \$80) and shall be subject to daily fines of \$30.00 to \$50.00. Persons who are physically disabled/restricted that cannot afford to clear their public walk may contact City Hall at 262.248.3673 for possible volunteer assistance through civic organizations.

NOTE: It is unlawful to plow or throw snow from private driveways and parking lots onto public streets and ways. This includes pushing snow across a street.

WINTER PARKING RESTRICTIONS

Effective from **11/15/22 to 3/31/23**, vehicles shall not park between the hours of 2:00 AM - 6:00 PM on any city street. However, during snow events, vehicles shall not park on the street until the snow has been plowed to the curb line. In addition, vehicles shall not park downtown from 3:00 am to 6:00 am at ANY time during the year. There is also no parking on the snow removal routes during removal operations according to city ord. 74-210 (e) (a,b,c). These routes shall be temporarily posted and **include downtown areas**. Vehicles parked in violation of these regulations shall be ticketed and/or towed away at owner's expense. Additional rules apply during snow storms (see city's website).
